2017 Sun Safe Billboard Contest

“There Is No Such Thing As A Safe Tan”

CREATE A PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENT TO BE FEATURED ON A LOCAL BILLBOARD
AND YOU COULD WIN **\$500!**

GOAL:

The goal of this contest is to educate 15-29 year olds by having them create a public service announcement (PSA) in the form of a billboard that showcases ways to protect their skin from sun damage and promote “safe skin”.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Be aged 15-29
- Must complete submission form
- If under 18 years of age, a parent permission form must also be completed
- Barry or Eaton County Resident

DEADLINE: Friday, April 21st, 2017 before 1pm

CONTEST RULES:

- Participants may work alone or may work in a team (\$500 prize will be split evenly among all members of winning team)
- Billboard design must focus on the dangers of tanning (outdoor, indoor, or both) and one or more of the “Sun Safe Behaviors” (see below)
- Billboard must be inspired by 1 or more factual statements provided by the CDC (http://www.cdc.gov/cancer/skin/basic_info/index.htm) or The Skin Cancer Foundation (<http://www.skincancer.org/>)
- All participants must be sure their design is original to them and not copied, borrowed or stolen
- Billboards will be judged on originality, creativity, content and representation of the contest theme
- Content must be appropriate for a G-rated audience

TIPS FROM THE EXPERTS (Adams Outdoor Creative Director):

- Use bright attractive colors
- Big text, contrasting colors
- Easy to read fonts (No cursive)
- Try to use no more than 9 words. 6-7 words is best.
- Catchy, easy tagline
- Big logo
- Simple, attractive photography (if photography is used)
- Graphic size: 11.167” x 5.207”

- .25" bleeds all the way around

Failure to follow contest rules will result in immediate disqualification.

SUBMISSION:

Submit a JPEG, PDF or other email-capable file with the design and required forms to Lauren Cibor at LCibor@BEDHD.org by Friday, April 21st, 2017 before 1pm.

PRIZES:

Winning team/ participant will have their billboard featured for 4 weeks on a billboard in their respective county and will receive a \$500* gift towards their education.

There will be one winning team/ participant chosen from Barry County and one winning team/ participant chosen from Eaton County. Each county winner will receive \$500.

*For entries with more than one participant, the \$500 prize will be split evenly among all members of winning team.

BACKGROUND

The incidence of skin cancer is greater than the incidence of lung, colon, breast, and prostate cancer combined! More than 5 million people are treated for skin cancer each year. Melanoma, a less common type of skin cancer, causes the most skin cancer-related deaths. Alarmingly, as opposed to other common forms of cancer, melanoma incidence has been increasing in recent decades. Over two-thirds of melanomas can be attributed to ultraviolet (UV) exposure. UV radiation is emitted from the sun and tanning devices. They cause DNA damage, which increases risk of developing cancer. The tanning of the skin we see with UV exposure is the body's way of mounting a defense against further DNA damage. (source: www.skincancer.org)

SUN SAFE BEHAVIORS

- Apply sunscreen regularly (at least SPF 30, broad spectrum UVA/UVB, containing zinc oxide or titanium dioxide)
- Seek shade when possible
- Wear protective clothing ("rash guard" swim shirts, long sleeved shirts, long pants, wide-brimmed hats, sunglasses)
- Avoid tanning beds
