

Vaccination Requirements for Foreign Exchange Students



Foreign exchange students must follow the State of Michigan immunization laws and requirements before beginning school!

Valid immunization forms must include:

- Physician signature
- Student name
- Student date of birth

Vaccines Required for School Entry in Michigan

Vaccination Type	Dose
Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis (DTP, DTaP, Tdap)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 4 doses D and T • 1 dose Tdap at 11 years of age or older upon entry into 7th grade or higher
Polio	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 4 doses • 3 doses if dose was given at or after 4 years of age
Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR) *	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2 doses at or after 12 months of age
Hepatitis B *	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 3 doses
Meningococcal Conjugate (MenACWY)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1 dose at 11 years of age or older upon entry into 7th grade or higher
Varicella (Chickenpox) *	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2 doses at or after 12 months of age or • Current lab immunity or history of varicella disease
*If the Child has not received these vaccines, documented immunity is required	

Did you know?

- During Disease outbreaks, incompletely vaccinated students may be excluded from school
- Parents and guardians choosing to decline vaccines must obtain a certified non-medical waiver from a local health department
- All doses of vaccines must be valid (correct spacing and ages) for school entry purposes
